5. REVIEW, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE FOLLOWING BOARD CASES.

A. Dr. Kaylee Thoreson, Case No. 17-068 – Investigative Interview

Dr. Thoreson was present, along with her Attorney Mr. Artie Eaves. Executive Director Gail Anthony gave an overview of the case.

Board member Dr. Sadilek made a motion to go into Executive Session for Legal Advice. Seconded by Ms. Tibbitts. Motion Carried 5 Ayes, 1 Absent, 1 Vacant. The Board resumed open session at 1:22 pm.

Dr. Thoreson addressed the Board explaining she changed patient SR's Thyroid medication based on patient history of a partial thyroidectomy, presenting symptoms, and the TSH, T4, T3 and DHEA lab results received 2 days prior to the visit. SR presented taking a compounded thyroid medication T4/T3 190 mcg/10 mcg. extended release. Dr. Thoreson prescribed WP Thyroid 130 mg. 2 tablets once a day before noon. Approximately 11 days post change in medication dosage, and while out of town, SR presented to an emergency department with increased anxiety, trouble swallowing and supraventricular tachycardia. Upon contacting the office after being released from the hospital, SR found Dr. Thoreson was out of town. She was advised she could speak with the associate physician, but she would have to pay a fee to do so. Upon phone consultation, a decrease in thyroid dosage to 65 mg was recommended with follow up labs.

SR was present and addressed the Board explaining prior to the emergency department visit, she had contacted the office several times for guidance on dosage and possible side effects, but was assured the dosage was correct. When she called the office for help after being released from the emergency department, the only way she could speak directly to a physician was to first pay a consultation fee of \$90.00. Once she gave her credit card information to the Receptionist, she was able to speak with a physician. She states the associate doctor was very rude, recommended a reduction in medication, and suggested she not return to the clinic.

Board member Dr. Sadilek stated making a major switch in dosage all at once can cause problems, and that it would have been better to do a gradual change instead.

Member Silbert commented that he believes this matter is more of a customer service issue related to Dr. Thoreson's staff, but would defer whether the prescribing was adequate to the other physician members. Dr. Eldridge questioned the complainant's mindset and credibility.

Board member Dr. Popiel expressed concerns that the new dose was essentially a 360% increase in T3, and the dosing of the thyroid medication is all at once, noting it would be better to dose in the morning and evening. He also advised he has concerns regarding the timing of the testing due to the length of time passed between the medication and the draw, may not show the true level of hormone in the system. Dr. Thoreson pointed out that the T4 was decreased at the same time.

Board member Mr. Silbert made a motion to issue a non-disciplinary order for 16 of CME in endocrinology. Board member Dr. Sadilek requested increasing the hours to 20. Board member Mr. Silbert amended his motion to reflect 20 hours of CME. Seconded by Dr. Sadilek. Roll Call: Dr. Popiel; Aye, Ms. Tibbitts; Nay, Mr. Silbert; Aye, Dr. Eldridge; Nay, Dr. Sadilek; Aye. B. Dr. Carolyn Fuller, Case No. 17-069 – Investigative Interview

Executive Director Gail Anthony gave an overview of the case. Dr. Fuller was present and addressed the Board explaining that when she prescribed the homeopathic remedy Nux Vomica it was to reduce stress. She claimed she did not want to tell patient GH what it was because she believed the fact that it is a tree nut would have no clinical value. She claims she focused on what homeopathy is and what the remedy is used for instead. She stated she realizes now that her response was not adequate. Dr. Fuller stated she made an EBV diagnosis based on lab results, and that she prescribed an antiviral as the treatment.

The Board took a brief recess and resumed regular session at 3:10 pm.

Patient GH was present and addressed the Board explaining his concerns. He informed the Board that although he presented to Dr. Fuller with a documented history of liver fibrosis, she prescribed Valtrex for a diagnosis of EBV. Valtrex is contraindicated for someone with liver damage. Under her prescription, GH was taking Valtrex for 4 months, and experienced a significant increase in fibromyalgia type symptoms. The medication was discontinued when Dr. Fuller realized it was the medication causing the symptoms. GH states Dr. Fuller never did any labs prior to or after prescribing the Valtrex. When Dr. Fuller prescribed Nux Vomica, he had been experiencing situational stressors. GH states he is very involved in his health care decisions, and began to ask her questions, however she refused to discuss what the remedy was, or to answer his questions, but simply told him it would take the edge off. Dr. Fuller ordered the medication, however it was not available that day. In an effort to find out what this remedy was, he went online and looked it up. He found Dr. Fuller again had prescribed him something which was contraindicated for someone with compromised liver function.

Board Member Mr. Heston asked GH if Dr. Fuller had taken the time to completely answer his questions about what the medication was, and treated him with the intellect he has, would he have filed the complaint. GH indicated that had Dr. Fuller answered his questions with full disclosure and had he been given the opportunity to address the medical advice given to him with his other treating physicians, he would have been able to arrive at an educated decision about his health care, and he probably would not have had a need to file a complaint.

Board member Dr. Eldridge stated that Dr. Fuller was confident that the homeopathic remedy she prescribed was safe, but it is sad that she failed to fully communicate and answer GH's questions. He opined that this situation eroded the level of trust GH must have once had in Dr. Fuller.

Board member Dr. Sadilek advised Dr. Fuller to review antiviral drugs and EBV, to complete liver function testing when appropriate, and to be sure to give patients full explanations when asked questions regarding medications.
