

To All Physicians;

Your Naturopathic Medical License must be renewed. The expiration date is January 1, 2017! Do not wait until the last minute to renew. The Board is not responsible for any problems you may encounter while using the online system, or delays in mailing. Late fees will be required if renewing after January 2, 2017 through March 1, 2017. The late fee cannot be waived.

To Renew Online:

1. Use the ONLINE OPTIONS you will be prompted to sign in with your name and last 4 digits of your SS #. You will complete the form and then you will be allowed to print your license.
2. During the process the system may AUDIT you, continue to renew. Be aware if you back out and start over, the system will notify the board that you have been audited.

To Renew with a paper application:

1. In Forms locate the 2017 Renewal Application (Fillable Form)
2. You will fill the blue spaces on the form, then use the print button at the bottom of the page then you will sign the application, then mail with the fee.
3. A complete renewal application along with the fee, must be supplied to the board on or before January 1, 2017

The license will automatically expire if not renewed by March 1, 2017. If you have not renewed your license during the renewal period, you will not be able to practice. You have the option to retire the license should you no longer want to hold an active license in the State of Arizona. As long as your license is current and in good standing, you may choose to retire the license during the renewal process. Should you choose to let the license automatically expire, payment of renewal and late fees for every year the license is not current, would be required as part of the reinstatement application.
